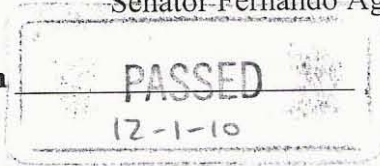

"A resolution supporting the Brazos Valley Shuttle Project."

- Whereas(1):** NASA's primary directive requires the shuttles to be used to promote science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) education; and,
- Whereas(2):** Texas A&M University is home to world renowned research and outstanding science and engineering programs; and,
- Whereas(3):** Brazos Valley is centrally located within the Continental United States, equidistant to the major cities in the State of Texas, and within driving distance of over 15 million citizens; and,
