WHEN: Camp will run from 9 am to 3 pm. Before and After Camp Care is available for an additional fee of \$5.00 per hour. All campers must arrange Before and After Camp Care prior to the day needed.

MEALS: Lunch *must* be provided for all children. **Please include 2 snacks and a water bottle.**
